NOTICE OF DISCONTINUANCE

DEFENDANT: (D.O.B.)

COURT AND HEARING DATE: Caernarfon Magistrates Court 2nd May, 2008

I am writing to inform you that I have today sent a notice to the Justices' Chief Executive, under section 23 of the Prosecution of Offences Act 1985, discontinuing the following charges against you/your client:

Keeper of vehicle failing to supply information as to driver's identity as required by or on behalf of Chief Officer of Police /2007 - /2007

The effect of this notice is that you no longer need to attend court in respect of these charges and that any bail conditions imposed in relation to them cease to apply.

The decision to discontinue these charges has been taken because

there is not enough evidence to provide a realistic prospect of conviction but please note it is anticipated further evidence may become available in the near future as a result of which the prosecution may well start again.

You have the right to require the discontinued proceedings to be revived. If you wish to exercise this right, you must give written notice to the Justices' Chief Executive at the above magistrates' court as soon as possible (and in any event within 35 days).
